## SCRIPTURE READING: Hebrews 4:14-16; Matthew 2:13-23 (selected verses below)

<sup>14</sup> Therefore, since we have a great high priest who has ascended into heaven, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold firmly to the faith we profess. <sup>15</sup> For we do not have a high priest who is unable to empathize with our weaknesses, but we have one who has been tempted in every way, just as we are—yet he did not sin. <sup>16</sup> Let us then approach God's throne of grace with confidence, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help us in our time of need.

<sup>13</sup> When they had gone, an angel of the Lord appeared to Joseph in a dream. "Get up," he said, "take the child and his mother and escape to Egypt. Stay there until I tell you, for Herod is going to search for the child to kill him."

<sup>14</sup> So he got up, took the child and his mother during the night and left for Egypt, <sup>15</sup> where he stayed until the death of Herod. And so was fulfilled what the Lord had said through the prophet: "Out of Egypt I called my son." <sup>17</sup> Then what was said through the prophet Jeremiah was fulfilled:

"A voice is heard in Ramah, weeping and great mourning, Rachel weeping for her children and refusing to be comforted, because they are no more."

## DISCUSSION PROMPTS FOR SMALL GROUPS, FRIEND GROUPS & HOUSEHOLDS:

- 1. What are some places you see Jesus "trading places" with someone (whether in the Bible or in your own life)?
- 2. What false expectations have you wrapped around Jesus? How might God want to disentangle those from the real Jesus?
- 3. Giving up our fairy-tale expectations is painful, but there are a lot of reasons Jesus is worth it. Why, right now, is he worth it to you?
- 4. What difference does it make that in Jesus, God knows all of the hardships of being human?
- 5. God doesn't always give us *reasons*, but he does produce *results*. In what ways have your shattered plans been a gift or produced fruit? In what areas are you still waiting for fruit to grow from your disappointments and hurts?
