**DATE** | Sunday, May 10th, 2026

**MESSAGE** | Listening is Hard

**SCRIPTURE** | John 1:1-3, 14; Phil. 2:3-4

**PRACTICE:** Incarnational Listening

- Give the speaker your undivided attention
- Listen holistically (*voice, face, body, tone*)
- Avoid judging and interpreting
- Restate what you heard in your own words
- Ask, "Is there more?"
- Ask, "Of everything you've shared, what do you most want me to remember?"
- Ask the speaker to give you honest feedback on how you did.

## DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- **Read the Scriptures listed above.** What stands out to you? What questions do these verses raise?
- What are the main obstacles to giving people your undivided attention?
- What tends to distract you when someone is trying to talk to you? What can you do about this?
- How are you being formed? Are you practicing fleeting, marginal attention? Or deep, sustained attention? Being present and curious? Or distracted and reactive?
